#### PARKING IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL

Please be aware of the bus loading zone in front of the school. You must park beyond the entrance to the parking lot. We receive many phone calls from the bus companies when vehicles are in the way of the buses entering or leaving the bus loading zone. Please do **not** park across from the school at any time – you may be ticketed.

#### ENTRY TO SCHOOL

Please be reminded that there are no teachers on duty until 8:15 am. Children, upon their arrival, are to line up for the entry bell at 8:25 am. They will be permitted early entry after 8:15 am & before 8:25 am for inclement weather (i.e. rain or wind chill temperatures lower than -25 c). Students may not enter the school to deposit school bags, etc. at an earlier time. If you are dropping your child off late, please enter via the office with your child and sign them in. Late arrivals <u>must</u> be reported to the office. If you are volunteering in your child's classroom, you must enter via the office and sign in to receive your visitor's tag.
