#### Morning bus arrival and drop off

#### **Dismissal**

All students will be dismissed at the doors located at the side parking lot. Reminder, for safety reasons, parents/guardians are not permitted to enter our parking lot. Please park on the street in designated areas and not the bus loading zone.

It is highly recommended that all students wear a mask. We will focus on hand washing, coughing and sneezing protocols for students. Pizza, pasta and milk will not be available at this time.

# HOME OF THE WIZARDS

Westmount Avenue PS is a nut controlled school. PLEASE DO NOT SEND food with any NUTS, this also includes WOW BUTTER, ALMOND BUTTER OR NUTELLA. If your child has an anaphylactic condition, please inform the classroom teacher and principal immediately.

#### Seesaw

In an attempt to reduce the flow of materials to and from school, we will continue to use the popular APP called Seesaw, to communicate with our parents. All our teachers used it last year and the reviews from parents were very positive. Seesaw is a free APP that can be downloaded to your cell phone or your home computer and it allows quick communication between the teacher and parent. All newsletters and all communication will be posted on Seesaw. If you don't have access to a cell phone or a computer, please advise us and we will arrange something for you. Your child's classroom teacher will be sending information home with further details. Please feel free to contact us if you have any questions.

#### **Our School Day**

All students enter via the parking lot doors between 8:15 and 8:25 am. After that time, please enter via the office to sign in your child. The entry bell rings at 8:25 a.m. Classes begin at 8:30 a.m. and finish at 2:50 p.m. Students exit via the parking lot doors unless they are being picked up early, then they will be sent to the office where we will sign them out and bring them to you. For safety reasons, vehicles or parents/guardians are not permitted in the parking lot. We ask that you park on the street being mindful of the bus loading zones.

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#### **Balanced Day**

With the Balanced Day schedule, students have two 40 minute breaks. The first break is considered a snack break. It should be nutritious, please no chips, chocolate bars, pop etc. Fruit and vegetables are great. The second break is their lunch. Pack foods that can easily be returned home if they are not eaten. It is better to pack too much then not enough. Don't forget utensils that might be needed. Please note, students do **NOT** have access to a microwave.

#### **Important Kindergarten Information**

All Kindergarten students have dismissal information tags on their backpacks. Please check this information and **please** do not remove the tag. If the tag is missing or information is incorrect **please call the school immediately for a replacement.** 

#### **Absences**

Notifying the school is incredibly important when your child is going to be absent or late. We need to know that your child is safe. Although you have sent a note via Seesaw regarding an absence or late, please follow through with a call to the office to avoid that safe arrival call. Our answering machine is always on. If you are arriving late please come to the office with your child.

Attendance and Punctuality is very important in a child's learning. Our school day begins at 8:30 and ends at 2:50. Even 5 minutes can make a difference in a child's learning. Please try to be on time and try to schedule appointments during PA days or after school.
